RATIONAL

The Abdominal and Urogenital MRI 2026 Erasmus Course offers a state of the art, comprehensive overview of abdominal and urogenital radiology in 2026 by means of an integrated multimodality approach and by combining in-depth lectures with interactive discussion on real clinical cases. Experts in the field will provide an update on topics from daily practices, will discuss the most recent innovations, trends, and concerns and practical challenges encountered and solutions adopted in the fields of abdominal and urogenital imaging.

The program of this 4-day intensive course is broad and includes high-yield lecture topics in hepatic, pancreatic, gastrointestinal, renal, female and male genital imaging, providing standardized imaging assessment systems, strategies for protocol optimization, incorporation of emerging advanced MRI techniques into routine practice.

During each of the first three days, there will be dedicated practical case-based sessions with review of full case examples of the different pathologies discussed during lectures providing practical suggestions on how to manage the diagnostic work-up of abdominal and urogenital diseases.
